APPLICATION PROCEDURE

- A. Applications can be obtained at the Boys' Haven Office located at 3655 N. Major Drive Beaumont, TX 77713 or online via the Boys Haven website
- B. Applications can be mailed to : PO Box 5815, Beaumont, TX 77726 or by email to: Nicole@boyshaven.com or submitted electronically via the website
- C. Once approved, the signed contract along with payment can only be submitted as cash, check, or via Paypal.
- D. The Boys' Haven Crawfish Festival's intent is to have a complimentary selection of products and offerings that add to the overall patron experience.

GENERAL POLICIES

- A. Any drawings or raffles must be previously approved by Festival Chairperson.
- B. All items to be sold or displayed must be "family appropriate". The Crawfish Festival Committee reserves the right to have any item not deemed appropriate removed from the view of the public.
- C. All food vendors are required to have a valid City of Beaumont Health Inspection and follow necessary safety practices.
- D. Great Lawn – The City of Beaumont does not allow any vehicle traffic on the lawn or spikes to be driven into the lawn.
- E. Booth space rental does not include any utilities – any electrical or water needs should be provided by Vendor.
- F. Boys' Haven is not responsible for loss or theft that may occur during this event.

SET UP / TEARDOWN

- A. Vendor setup can begin at 7:00am on day of the event. Please make sure and bring carts, dollies or whatever means necessary to move products and supplies into space.
- B. All "pop-up" tents should be weighted down to protect patrons and other Vendors.
- C. All vendors should remain open for business until 6:00pm.
