GENERAL POLICIES

- Booth space does not include any items. Plan to bring a table, chairs, a tent, and any other items you may need for this outdoor event. Booths do not include any electricity.
- Nonprofit Vendors are part of the Kid Zone and must have a free kid activity available at their table. Examples include: bubbles, coloring pages, stickers, small toy giveaways
- All <u>Food Vendors</u> are required to have a valid City of Beaumont Health Inspection and follow necessary safety practices.
- Boys' Haven is not responsible for loss or theft that may occur during this event.

SET UP / TEARDOWN

- The event is open 10am to 6pm. Vendor setup can begin as early 8:00am and should remain open until 6pm.
- Vendors can unload vehicles for set up and then must park at the First Baptist Church next door.
- All "pop-up" tents should be weighed down for safety.
